<b>BIBLE STUDY PRINCIPLES</b> An analysis of how to study and understand Scripture. Emphasis will be placed on the specific rules used to interpret biblical narratives, poetry, parables and prophecy and on the vital methods used to apply a passage.	7	February 7 to March 28 (2015)  Breaks: March 21 April 4
<b>OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY 1</b> An introduction to the books of the Old Testament, employing thematic methods. Literary structure, historical background, and parallel passages are also utilized to discover the unique and priceless lessons of each book.	10	April 11 to June 13 (2015)  Break: June 20
<b>OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY 2</b> Continuation of Old Testament Survey 1	10	June 27 to August 29 Break: Sep 5
<b>NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY</b> An introduction to the books of the New Testament, with special emphasis on the life, teachings, and redemptive work of Christ, the founding and growth of the church, and the teachings of the epistles and Revelation. On the basis of the biblical text, parallel readings, projects and lectures, the events and messages of the New Testament will be portrayed against their historical and cultural setting.	14	September 12 to November 28 (2015) + January 9 to January 16 (2016)  Breaks: All of December January 2 January 23

<b>BIBLE DOCTRINE SURVEY</b> A survey of Christian theology in the areas of God, the Bible, Angels, Christ, the Holy Spirit, Humanity, Sin, Salvation, the Church, and Last Things.	14	January 30 to May 14 (2016)  Breaks: March 26 April 9 May 21
<b>THE CHRISTIAN LIFE</b> An integration of the vital concepts and an exposition of key passages in the New Testament relating to the spiritual lifestyle, featuring a study of such subjects as sanctification, confession, forgiveness, Christian liberty and interpersonal relationships.	7	May 28 to July 9 (2016)  Break: July 16
<b>BIBLICAL CHURCH LIFE</b> A foundational study of critical issues related to the spiritual health and direction of the local church. Topics may include leadership, planning, worship, evangelism, discipleship, biblical counseling and missions. This class will also reinforce convictions on biblical theology in areas of particular importance in the Philippines.	7	July 23 to September 3 (2016)  Break: September 10
<b>TEACHING THE BIBLE</b> Training in preparation, organization, and delivery of the biblical text to an audience of hearers. The focus will be on preparation of devotionals and messages for small group lessons and Bible studies.	7	September 17 to October 29 (2016)
